Pupil Premium – helping your child

Every year the school is given money by the Government to ensure no children are vulnerable to underachieving at school. The Pupil Premium money is given in respect of children who:

- Have a low family income
- Are in care, adopted or looked after by the County Council
- Has a parent in the Armed Services.

The school uses this money carefully to support these children by providing the following services when required:

- Additional learning support
- Access to the school ELSA [Emotional Literacy Support Assistant]
- Free school milk, trips and enrichment activities
- Access to after school clubs
- Assistance with uniform
