

### Stop, Look and Listen

At Oakwood we always put the safety of the children first. Church Lane is particularly busy during drop off and pick up times with cars often travelling too fast to get to their destination. Please read these top road safety tips with your child to ensure they know how to cross the road safely with an adult:

- \* hold your grown-up's hand– don't run ahead
- \* with your grown-up choose a safe place to cross, try not to cross a road between parked cars as drivers won't be able to see you very well and the cars might start moving
- \* when it's safe to cross, remember to walk straight across the road and keep looking and listening out for traffic
- \* remember to concentrate and try not to get easily distracted by what is going on around you
